

Purvai; warm wind from the east is An Lanntair's festival of South Asian arts and culture, celebrating the surprising and diverse South Asian heritage and connections in the Western Isles.

This year's festival will bring a really special programme of activities, concerts and performances for the whole family to come along and enjoy. There will be everything from Indian classical music from renowned Sitarist, Roopa Panesar and the Asian Blues of Aziz and Dal, to poetry and storytelling from Pakistan, to drumming and arts workshops for all the family. Something for everyone – come along and we look forward to bringing some warm winds from the east to inspire us all! The Purvai Festival has been created from several years of exchange and research in South Asia, involving artist exchanges between the Hebrides and India, and An Lanntair's research project into the Colin Mackenzie collection; the first surveyor general of All India and a collector extraordinaire, whose collection of South Asian antiquities is famous worldwide.
