This is a fantastic opportunity for a young person aged 17 or over to gain invaluable experience in the creative and arts industries. This summer placement based at An Lanntair arts centre in Stornoway will be focused on supporting the digital marketing, documentation and evaluation of the Creative Place Awards Bealach programme <http://lanntair.com/bealach/>.

About An Lanntair

An Lanntair is a multi arts venue – at one and the same time a contemporary art gallery, a theatre, a cinema, a concert hall, a platform for poetry and literature, a studio – every space is stretched to showcase the arts in multiple forms. Encompassing it all, we pride ourselves in presenting an inspirational programme of excellence that engages and illuminates its audiences. Our work stretches across a national and indeed international platform, yet our distinctiveness lies in being ‘of the place’, rooted in who we are, and the creativity of Gaelic and the Outer Hebrides takes centre stage. In October 2005, following a ten year campaign, our magnificent, nationally significant new arts centre on the Stornoway waterfront was opened. Our facility includes a 220 seat auditorium, gallery space, office space, shop, bar and restaurant facilities. The building was one of the largest ever arts developments in the Highlands and Islands and is of key strategic importance nationally for the arts and culture of the Outer Hebrides.

About Bealach

An Lanntair is working with a diverse partnership of organisations across the Isles of Lewis and Harris to deliver the Bealach Project. Bealach is a wide reaching project to be delivered over 2015-2017 with funding secured through winning Creative Scotland’s Creative Place Awards 2015. Bealach seeks to represent the Isles of Lewis and Harris as the ‘gateway’ and ‘passage’ into the Gaelic culture, creative communities and landscape of the Outer Hebrides.

The programme includes innovative artist residencies; world class Gaelic music and performing arts in intriguing and unusual places; arts trails; curated exhibitions; walking and Segway tours incorporating bilingual digital storytelling; mentoring support for young emerging artists, and programmes of staff development raising the quality of the visitor experience.



About this role

We will be looking for an enthusiastic young person with some skills in graphic design, editing, film, photography and administration. The aim of the placement will be to attend and document in a creative way the summer programme of events for Bealach. So, for example our Harris Tweed Festival, the exhibitions, the Hebridean Celtic Festival Gaelic stage events, the Cèilidh Trails, the Purvai South Asian Festival, the Gaelic Psalm performance, the Bus Shelter arts commissions and a bunch of other projects and activities.

The key tasks will be to:

- Visit and document all Creative Place Awards projects
- Attend events
- Write blog entries
- Undertake filming and photography of events and activities
- Editing of film and content
- Other administrative tasks

Along with the opportunity to experience working on these incredible projects, the successful young person will also receive training and plenty of other opportunities to develop their own skills and experience. It is an exciting chance for any ambitious young person to really kick off their career in the creative industries.
