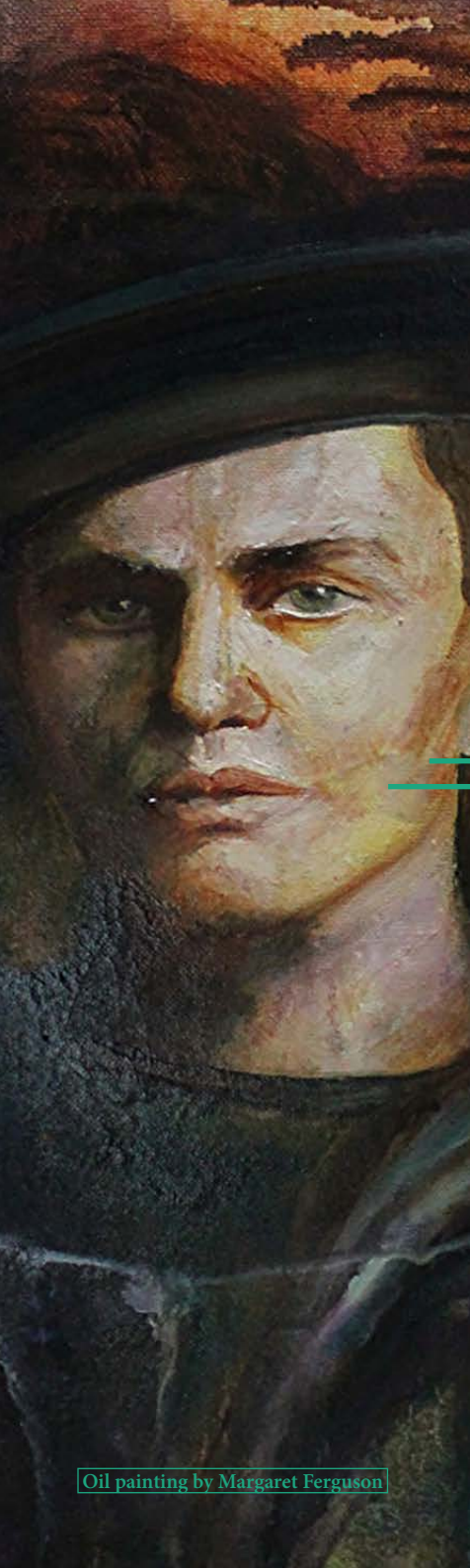

**W**elcome to our autumn brochure. Autumn will see some of our most outstanding projects of recent years come to fruition here at An Lanntair. Perhaps the most significant of which will be our programme of world class events and public art projects to commemorate the Centenary of the Iolaire disaster on Lewis. For this reason, I would like to handover the brochure introduction this season to Roddy Murray, Founding Director of An Lanntair, and Head of Visual arts and Literature, to provide some context for this work....

**T**hey say that history will tell you what happened. Art will tell you what it felt like.

This year has been dominated by the forthcoming Centenary of the Iolaire disaster. Our work at An Lanntair includes major exhibitions and music commissions and extends to a new public art sculpture at the Holm site, which will be the focus for the formal dedications on the morning of the 1st January 2019. Beyond the Armistice, it will be the last official, national event to commemorate The Great War of 1914-18.

## Roddy Murray

A' Chiad Stiùiricheanaird | Founding Director

In 1993 when researching for an audio-visual programme, I was intrigued by the dearth of visual resource, information and conversation about the Iolaire. So much silence. Yet it is so deeply embedded in the Islands' subconscious that it can never be erased or forgotten. And when planning on how we could make a sincere, significant, appropriate contribution that would do justice to the commemoration, it seemed apparent to me that a permanent memorial was a priority.

They say that history will tell you what happened. Art will tell you what it felt like. The design for the Centenary Sculpture references John Finlay Macleod who swam ashore with the rope by which so many were saved. This lifeline, not only symbolises heroism and rescue, it ties us to the past, links land and sea, from ship to shore, while the bronze coil echoes the emotional vortex into which the Island fell on that deepest and darkest night
